Literacy

Focusing on the topic of space, children will start to plan and write their own adventure stories using examples taken from 'Star Wars'.

We will also be revising the skills they have learnt so far in order for them to incorporate these into their writing.

Science *Light*


Children will learn about different light sources and how they reflect from different surfaces. We will also briefly cover how shadows are formed and how they differ depending on the material.

Children will explore the importance of sun safety and will discuss ways in which they can protect themselves.

Topic Space Explorers

Throughout this half term, we will be focusing on space exploration as our topic. We will learn about our solar system and beyond, the moon, space travel and will be discussing the reasons as to why we have day and night.

We will make historical links to the first moon landing and discuss the current role of astronauts.



Computing

We will be continuing to learn about computer programming. Children will learn about the specific language and important steps to becoming a computer programmer.
